

matters, including those asserted by the *Williams* Plaintiffs² to the extent those objections and arguments are properly before the Court, as the Court has the authority to consider and rule on matters relevant to jurisdiction, including standing. Plaintiffs' Motion for Final Approval of the Settlement shall be filed 10 days before the Final Approval Hearing.

The Final Approval Hearing may be postponed or rescheduled by order of the Court without further notice to the Settlement Class, but any rescheduled date will be posted on the Settlement Website, www.AlabamaTexasPEXsettlement.com, and available through the Settlement toll-free number. Counsel for Plaintiffs and Defendant should coordinate to ensure that accurate information is posted on the Settlement Website regarding this order and the Final Approval Hearing.
