

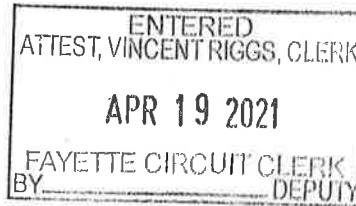

ORDER ON MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 19, 2021, the Court issued an Order, among other things, directing attorneys Katherine Yunker, as Class Counsel, and Jeremy Rogers, as counsel for Defendant Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association, to tender by April 5, 2021 a proposed Opinion and Order memorializing the Court's rulings from the Bench regarding all aspects of the Partial Settlement at issue in the fairness hearing conducted in this case on February 24, March 1, March 8, 2021. Ms. Yunker and Mr. Rogers filed a joint motion on April 2, 2021 requesting an extension of time. After hearing the matter on April 9, 2021, at which time movants stated their intent to tender two proposed opinions and orders (one relating to the fee requests and the other to the proposed settlement) and the proceedings at the fairness hearing were discussed with counsel for the parties, and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion is SUSTAINED. Ms. Yunker and Mr. Rogers shall submit the proposed Opinions and Orders, with copies to all counsel, no later than April 30,

2021. No further extensions shall be granted. The parties shall have five full (5) business days after tender and service of a proposed Opinion and Order in which to file any objection thereto.
