FINAL JUDGMENT

The Court, having entered the Order of Final Approval of Settlement, dated 2/14, 2020 (ECF No.), hereby **ENTERS JUDGMENT** as follows:

1. The Court incorporates herein by reference the Order of Final Approval of Settlement (ECF No. 159), which granted final approval to the Settlement Agreement (ECF No. 134-1)¹, certified the Settlement Class for settlement purposes, and granted Plaintiff's requests for attorneys' fees, reimbursement for expenses and Service Award to Plaintiff.

2. This Action is hereby dismissed with prejudice as to all parties and all Settlement Class Members, each side to bear its own fees and costs except as otherwise provided in the Settlement Agreement and Order of Final Approval of Settlement.

3. Plaintiff and all Settlement Class Members, including any objectors, are hereby barred and enjoined from asserting any of the Released Claims, including, but


without limitation, during any appeals from the Order of Final Approval of Settlement or this Final Judgment.

4. Those persons identified on the List of Exclusions attached hereto as Exhibit A are hereby excluded from the Settlement. They shall not receive any distribution from the Settlement and are not bound by the Order of Final Approval of Settlement or this Final Judgment.

5. The Confidentiality Agreement (ECF No. 41) shall survive the termination of this Action and continue in full force and effect after entry of the Order of Final Approval of Settlement and this Final Judgment.

6. Without affecting the finality of this judgment, the Court retains continuing and exclusive jurisdiction over all matters relating to the administration, consummation, enforcement, and interpretation of the Settlement Agreement and of the Order of Final Approval of Settlement, to protect and effectuate this Final Judgment, and for any other necessary purpose. The Plaintiff, Defendants, and the Settlement Class Members are hereby deemed to have irrevocably submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of this Court, for the purpose of any suit, action, proceeding, or dispute arising out of or relating to the Settlement. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, and without affecting the finality of this Final Judgment, the Court retains exclusive jurisdiction over any such suit, action, or proceeding. Solely for purposes of such suit, action, or proceeding, to the fullest extent they may effectively do so under applicable law, the parties are deemed to have irrevocably waived and agreed not to assert, by way of motion, as a defense or otherwise, any claim or objection that they are not subject to the jurisdiction of this Court, or that this Court is, in any way, an improper venue or an inconvenient forum.
