WHEREAS, none of Defendants The Gap, Inc., Gap (Apparel), LLC, Gap International Sales, Inc., Banana Republic, LLC, and Banana Republic (Apparel), Inc. (collectively, the "Defendants"), has filed an Opposition to the Motion;
