~~PROPOSED~~  ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO OPT OUT OR OBJECT TO
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Parties have notified the Court that they are prepared to send notice to the Settlement Class via email pursuant to Court’s Order of December 11, 2019. *See* ECF 37. In order to ensure that recipients of this email notice have sufficient time to respond, the Parties have requested that the deadlines for objecting to or opting out of the Settlement be extended, and that the email notice itself reflect the extended deadlines. Having reviewed the Parties’ request, and finding there to be good cause, the deadlines for objecting to or opting out of the Settlement are hereby modified, as follows:

1. The deadline by which any Settlement Class Member may object to the Settlement Agreement is hereby extended from December 30, 2019, to January 21, 2020. Objections must comply with ¶¶ 12-15 and ¶¶ 17-18 of the Court’s Order Preliminarily Approving the Class Action Settlement, ECF 33, which is available on the Settlement Website.

2. The deadline by which any Settlement Class Member who wishes to be excluded from the Class may elect to opt out of the monetary portion of the Class Settlement is extended to January 21, 2020, and any letter must be postmarked by that date.


3. The date by which any Settlement Class Member who intends to appear at the Final Fairness Hearing must file a Notice of Intention to Appear is extended from January 13, 2020, to January 24, 2020.

4. Class Counsel and Defendant shall have the right to respond to any objection no later than January 24, 2020.

5. The date by which the Settlement Administrator shall file a list of those persons who have opted out or excluded themselves from the Settlement is hereby extended from January 17, 2020 to January 24, 2020. The Settlement Administrator shall file a supplement to the opt out list if it receives additional opt out requests after January 24, 2020, that were postmarked on or prior to January 21, 2020.
