ORDER

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the parties’ Joint Motion for Extension and Clarification (Doc. No. 72). After considering the motion, and for the reasons stated therein and good cause shown, the motion is GRANTED. The Court hereby ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Because the parties agreed that 217 individuals have already sent back a consent form to participate as party plaintiffs, no notice or claim form will need to be mailed to these individuals in order for them to recover their pro-rated settlement amounts, and those individuals would nevertheless release all FLSA and state law claims as described in the parties’ agreement. See (Doc. No. 63-1, p. 9, 25);

2. The Notice and Claim Form may be issued via US Mail and email as agreed and Ordered, not via text message;

3. The Parties may correct the notice documents to correctly reflect that the timeframe for the release of claims is up to the date of the Court’s final approval of settlement, consistent with the parties’ settlement agreement and Court’s Order; and

4. The deadline to send notice and relevant forms of the proposed settlement

agreement to class members shall be extended, up to and including, January 22, 2020.
