ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED
MOTION FOR PAYMENT OF
SETTLEMENT ADMINISTRATION
COSTS

BEFORE THE COURT is Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Payment of Settlement Administration Costs, ECF No. 158. Plaintiff asks the Court to authorize payment to Angeion, the Settlement Administrator, from the Settlement Fund in the amount of up to \$78,500.00, consistent with the Settlement Agreement. *Id.* at 4.

The Court has considered the motion, the record, and is fully informed.

Through May 30, 2020, Angeion incurred \$50,365.37 in settlement administration fees and costs related to settlement-related tasks. Angeion estimates

1 that it will incur an additional \$35,785.00 to complete settlement administration. At
2 this time, Class Counsel asks that the Court authorize payment up to \$78,500.00, the
3 cap that Angeion provided when estimating its costs prior to sending notice to Class
4 Members.

5 The Court finds good cause to authorize payment to Angeion from the
6 Settlement Fund up to \$78,500.00, provided that Angeion's actual fees and expenses
7 are at least that amount. Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff's
8 Unopposed Motion for Payment of Settlement Administration Costs, **ECF No. 158**,
9 is **GRANTED**.

10 **IT IS SO ORDERED.** The District Court Clerk is directed to enter this
11 Order and provide copies to counsel.
