THIS CAUSE came on before the undersigned Superior Court Judge assigned to this action by the Chief Justice of the North Carolina Supreme Court pursuant to Rule 2.1 of the North Carolina General Rules of Practice by consent of the parties on Plaintiffs/Class Representatives' Unopposed Motion to Approve Class Notice Program pursuant to Rule 23 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

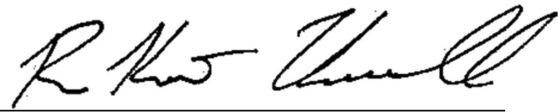
