Settlement Class Members must submit an attestation that they spent the claimed time responding to issues raised by the Incident. Settlement Class Members will also need to choose from a mutually agreeable array of activities for which they spent time dealing with the Incident for which they can be compensated.
- ✓ <u>Compensation for Extraordinary Losses</u> (up to \$3,000 per Settlement Class Member) *Documentation Required

Extraordinary losses are losses associated with identity theft, fraud, and other actual misuse of personal information, provided that:

- 1. the loss is an actual documented and unreimbursed monetary loss;

To the extent the total amount of the Valid Claims does not exceed the Settlement Floor the Valid Claims shall be increased in an amount *pro rata* so that the Settlement Floor is met. To the extent the total amount of the Valid Claims exceeds \$100,000 to Settlement Class Members, the Valid Claims shall be decreased in an amount *pro rata*.
