

action settlement proceedings, *see* ECF No. 170 at 13-19 (¶ 21);

WHEREAS, as contemplated by the Preliminary Approval Order, S&P Global Automotive (formerly known as IHS Markit) was retained to obtain the names and addresses of owners and lessees of Class Vehicles from the motor vehicle departments of all fifty (50) U.S. states and the District of Columbia, *see* ECF No. 170 at 7 (¶ 14);

WHEREAS, S&P Global Automotive has stated that it has been able to obtain the vast majority of such data but has not yet been able to obtain all such data, despite its due diligence;

WHEREAS, Angeion Group (“Angeion”), which is serving as the third-party settlement administrator pursuant to the Court’s Order (ECF No. 172), has indicated that the delay in receiving all of the Class Vehicle registration data will prevent it from mailing the Class Notice by the deadline set forth by ECF No. 170 at 15 (¶ 21);

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Approval Order contemplated that “if an additional thirty (30) days is reasonably necessary to obtain the information for providing notice,” an extension of the deadlines set forth below could be requested, *see* ECF No. 170 at 15 n.2 (¶ 21);

WHEREAS, based on discussions with S&P Global Automotive and Angeion, Defendant anticipates that modifying the settlement administration deadlines by extending all deadlines in ¶ 21 of the Preliminary Approval Order (*see* ECF No. 170 at 13-19) by an additional thirty (30) days should afford sufficient time to provide notice to the class;

WHEREAS, the Parties have conferred regarding possible methods to commence class notice mailings as soon as possible (*i.e.*, to the portion of class members for whom Angeion has received information for providing notice), but approval of the extensions proposed by this Stipulation are required to commence *any* class notice mailings because the notice to class

members needs to include dates certain for, *inter alia*, the deadlines for requests for exclusion and objection, which will be impacted by approval of this Stipulation;

WHEREAS, based on discussions with Angeion, Defendant anticipates that, once this Court has an opportunity to rule on this proposed stipulation notice to the class members will be able to commence, including, the notice mailing process for those class members for whom addresses have already been collected, and will commence substantially before the proposed extended notice deadline.

IT IS, on this 25th day of March 2025, **ORDERED** that the following schedule shall govern the class action settlement proceedings:
